St. John's Day Observance

The George Washington Masonic Memorial is pleased to present this year's holiday ornament: St. John's Day Observance. It depicts General Washington and his officers attending Christ Church in Philadelphia for a St. John's Day Observance on December 28, 1778. Under the auspices of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, the Observance raised money to help alleviate suffering of the citizens during the British occupation. The British evacuated Philadelphia in June of 1778. In December, Washington visited Philadelphia where Congress was in session. While there, the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania celebrated the festival of St. John the Evangelist. Washington was present on the occasion, and was honored with the chief place in the procession.
